**PROCLAMATION TERMINATING EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION**  
**Bonney Lake, Washington**

**WHEREAS**, beginning September 8, 2020 the Sumner Grade Wildfire created a threat to life, property, and the environment; and

**WHEREAS**, this fire constituted an emergency as defined by the City of Bonney Lake Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and necessitated the utilization of emergency powers granted pursuant to City of Bonney Lake Municipal Code 8.44, RCW 36.40.180 and RCW 38.52.070(2); and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of this emergency the Bonney Lake Mayor declared an emergency in Bonney Lake by issuance of a proclamation dated September 8, 2020; and


**WHEREAS** the impacts of that emergency no longer exist and in the judgment of the undersigned, it is time to end the City's state of emergency and rescind the Emergency Proclamation based on the Sumner Grade Wildfire.

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, Michael McCullough, Mayor of Bonney Lake, do hereby proclaim:


***The Proclamation of Emergency issued by the
