Street Sweeping Program and Schedule

Area of Service:

One monthly cycle within the city is 148 lane miles. One monthly cycle, including SR-410, is 171 Lane Miles.

Street Sweeping Schedule:

Arterial and Collector streets:

The Street Sweeper will concentrate on the Arterial and collector streets during the **First Week** of every month. Arterial and collector streets are considered priority due to a higher volume of traffic within the city. During the early Fall/Winter (leaf season), following a snow or storm event, these streets will also take priority over other streets during cleanup operations.

Curb & Gutter streets:

The street sweeper will sweep all other curb & gutter streets on the **second/third week** of each month. These streets exist primarily in home tracks or developments. These take priority over streets w/out curb & gutter due to the sensitivity of the storm drain systems.

Streets w/out curb & gutter:

The sweeper will sweep the remaining streets, (w/out curb & gutter), by following the Sweeper Checklist. This checklist is organized by geographical sections within the city limits. As each

street is swept, the operator will record the date on the checklist to ensure that every street is clean. These streets will be swept during the **third/forth week**.

Note: Following a weather event, some of the streets w/out curb & gutter may be swept using the city's side cast sweeper. This will enable the city crew to expedite sweeping during cleanup operations.

State Route 410:

Due to the speed limit and the volume of traffic on SR-410, additional safety measures must be used to protect workers. A truck mounted attenuator is used as a protection vehicle and serves as a crash cushion should a vehicle fail to merge out of the closed lane. A portable changeable message sign is deployed to provide advance warning to drivers before the merge point. Work on SR-410 is done in increments of safety. Since this equipment is providing a safety buffer, a crew will pick-up the trash along the roadside simultaneously. SR 410 is usually swept **once a Quarter,** with the exception of a storm event.

Early Fall/Winter (Leaf Season):

We take great pride in serving the community and making sure that it looks as good as possible. As you may be aware, our Street Maintenance staff maintains over 170 lane miles of roadway within our City limits. Because of that, we have to keep moving as efficiently as possible so that all of our citizens receive the service they deserve.
